*Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers,
Yachtsmen and Seafarers*

Kinsale Head and Seven Heads Gas Fields - decommissioning activities on subsea infrastructure

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised that Kinsale Energy plan to undertake decommissioning activities on the subsea infrastructure in the Kinsale Head and Seven Heads Gas Fields. The works are due to commence on or around **10 May 2022** and are estimated to last 20 days. However, please note the start date and the duration of the activity are weather dependent.

2. Location of Activity

The operations will take place in the locations indicated in the Table below. It should be noted that the offshore operations will not necessarily take place in the order detailed in the Table. Further location information is available in Appendix 1.

3. Details of the Survey Vessel

The survey will be conducted by the “**Skandi Constructor**” Construction Support Vessel (call sign **C6ZH8**). These works will involve the use of subsea construction equipment, on and around the subsea infrastructure at the locations listed above. Work will involve remotely operated vehicles/equipment and no diving operations will take place. The vessel can be contacted on VHF Ch. 13.

All vessels operating within this area are requested to keep their distance and pass at minimum speed to reduce vessel wash.
