Irish Air Corps Air to Ground Live Firing Exercise D1 Gormanston Ranges

The Department of Transport has been advised that the Irish Air Corps will conduct Air to Ground Air Firing Exercises in the Gormanston D1 Air Range, Co. Meath on Thursday 27 October and Friday 28 October 2022.

Live firing will take place on Thursday 27 October between 1200 and 2100 Hrs and on Friday 28th October between 11:00 and 16:00 Hrs.

An Activation Notice – Danger Area D1 – Gormanston will be issued. The Officer in charge of firing on each day will be fully briefed regarding communication between the firing point and the Air Traffic Control Centre at Dublin Airport. The NAVAL Service or AC RHIB will enforce exclusion zone.
